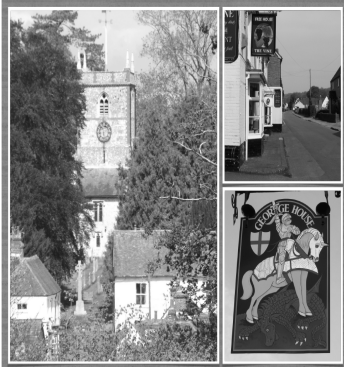

This 'Public Services, Facilities and Environment' Questionnaire follows up the 'General' Questionnaire issued in the last *Hambledonian*.
